

# **Zimbabwe: Will the Inclusive Government collapse?**

There is still stalemate on key unresolved issues from the Global Political Agreement. It is reported that SADC has been mediating in closed sessions in South Africa and that Prime Minister Tsvangirai and President Zuma have met at the Davos Economic Forum.

The MDC are pressing for resolution of such issues as appointment of Governor of Reserve Bank and Attorney General and general lack of progress following the formation of the Inclusive Government on 11 February 2009.

The EU is due to take a decision whether or not to renew its measures in February. Human Rights Watch in a statement of 29 January calls on the EU to retain the measures as the reasons they were imposed still apply.

Zanu PF is saying they will not make any concessions until the EU and others withdraw their sanctions/targeted measures (travel bans on named individuals).
